1. All application forms must be sent direct to the above address to arrive no later than 1st March 2009
 2. Acknowledgement of receipt of your application and deposit will be by your receipt of the first Contingent Newsletter. Individual receipts will not be issued.
 3. A **3%** Credit Card processing fee will apply on total fees paid and charged with the last payment

Applications after 31/10/2009 will attract a \$100 late application fee however, late applicants cannot be guaranteed attendance at the Jamboree because of the need to finalise arrangements.

Jamboree Pricing

The total Jamboree Fee as above is made up of the Jamboree Fee set by the Jamboree Organising Committee plus a Contingent Fee which is set by the NT Jamboree Organising Committee.

For all participants the Jamboree Fee covers meals, activities including admission fees (not Venturer Scouts and Adults), camping fees, Jamboree Manual and the following: Jamboree Scarf, Badges, Shirt and Hat and the Contingent Fee covers other items such as transport, equipment, souvenirs, insurance and the following: NT Contingent Shirt, Contingent Badges, Large Wheelie Bag and Swap Badges.

Withdrawal Policy

If after making application, you are unable to attend the Jamboree, you must advise the Contingent HQ in writing as soon as possible. Please note that the Application Fee of \$50.00 is not refundable.

- Withdrawal Policy**
- * Withdraw after 31 May 2009 – refund all but \$150.00
 - * Withdraw after 31 July 2009 – refund all but \$250.00
 - * Withdraw after 31 September 2009 – no refund
(except in case of exceptional circumstances)

The Jamboree Organising Committee reserves the right to refuse any application in which case a full refund will be made.

Transport Arrangements

The Jamboree Organising Committee will be arranging air transport (the preferred mode of travel) to and from the Jamboree and it is expected that all members will travel with the Contingent. Meals and drinks during travel will be at each members own expense. Depending upon the cost of group airfares, there is a possibility that coach travel may be used instead.

All members are expected to travel with the Contingent. Should any Members wish to travel independently to and/or from the Jamboree they will need to advise the reason and details in writing and submit this advice with their applications. If approved, independent travellers must travel to and/or from the Jamboree site arriving and/or departing at a specific date/time which will be notified closer to the Jamboree.
