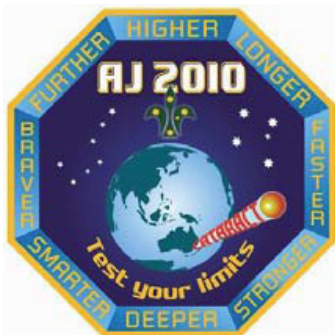

## **NEW ZEALAND CONTINGENT INFORMATION**

### **Eligibility:**

#### **Scouts:**

- Must be an invested Scout with a New Zealand Scout Troop.
- Must have a current passport.
- Must have had their 11<sup>th</sup> birthday by 4<sup>th</sup> January 2010.
- Must **NOT** have had their 16<sup>th</sup> Birthday by 4<sup>th</sup> January 2010.
- Preferred to have camped 10 nights under canvas – 3 of these consecutively.

#### **Ventures:**

- Must be an invested Venture with a New Zealand Venture Unit.
- Must have a current passport.
- Must have had their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday by 4<sup>th</sup> January 2010.
- Must **NOT** have had their 18<sup>th</sup> Birthday by 4<sup>th</sup> January 2010.
- Must to have camped 10 nights under canvas – 5 of these consecutively.
- Note: There are some additional guidelines' for Venturers and these will be clarified and published soon.
- Venturers – Any Venturers you may have in the Contingent must have a Venturer Leader supervising in the lines with them.
- Must complete a 'Prohibited Employment Declaration (PED) Form'. (attached to registration form).
- Note: Venturers will be allocated tasks in the 'Jamboree Service Area'.

#### **Rovers / Adult Leaders:**

- Must be a warranted Leader within Scouting NZ.
- Must have a current passport.
- Must complete a 'Prohibited Employment Declaration (PED) Form'. (attached to registration form).
- Note: Leaders will be allocated a Patrol to work with or a role in the 'Jamboree Service Area'.

**SCOUT APPLICANTS ARE REMINDED THAT ATTENDANCE AT JAMBOREE IS A PRIVILEGE, NOT A RIGHT, AND THAT BEHAVIOUR STANDARDS WILL BE MONITORED OVER THE PERIOD FROM POINT OF APPLICATION ACCEPTANCE TO FINAL APPLICATION APPROVAL DATE TO ASCERTAIN ATTENDANCE ELIGIBILITY.**

Please complete **all** parts of this application form.

Ensure that parent(s) or guardian(s) where applicable sign the indemnity (Leaders, & Rovers sign themselves).

Obtain the required signatures as follows:

**Scouts:** Scout Leader, Group Leader

**Junior Service Leaders (Venturers)** Venturer Leader, Group Leader

**Leaders/Rovers:** Group Leader/Crew Leader(Rovers) or next appropriate level of Commissioner and **Zone Leader (Scouts)**

and forward the application form (except this page).

## Notes on Payment

1. All application forms must be sent via your Group to arrive at National Office no later than **9<sup>th</sup> April, 2009**.
2. To facilitate contingent banking and records management, all payments must be by Scout Group cheque.

**Late applications** cannot be guaranteed attendance at the Jamboree because of the need to finalise Contingent travel and hosting arrangements.

## Costs:

**Total: \$2600.00 – Refer to Newsletter #2 for cost breakdown.**

**NOTE:** Until we have final numbers, we cannot confirm costs however we believe that we have been conservative in our estimates and the final amount will not exceed the total stated. Be assured any surplus monies at end of event will be refunded. Also we have not factored in pocket money for the individuals at Jamboree.

**Payment Dates:** (No later than)

### Deposit:

- Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> April 2009 - **\$500.00** – with signed official registration forms.

### 1<sup>st</sup> Installment:

- Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> July 2009 - **\$1000.00**

### Final Installment:

- Friday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2009 – **\$1100.00**

### On Line Registration.

- Go to AJ2010 website <http://scoutsaj2010.com/#> .
- Click on Jamboree Applications button
- Fill out details in 'New Registration' section and click on 'Register'.
  - **Remember your 'Password'.**
- When you receive the confirmation e-mail – log back in and fill out rest of personal details, including inserting photo.
- When form all filled out – PRINT hardcopy.
- Fill out OPS23 form (attached).
- Get both forms signed as required and send it along with deposit (\$500.00) to:
  - **Scouting New Zealand, PO Box 11348, Wellington 6142.**

### Off Line Registration:

- Complete and Print off both forms attached to this newsletter
  - OPS23 – Application to attend overseas event.
  - AJ2010 – International Participant Application.
- Get both forms signed as required and send it along with deposit (\$500.00) to:
  - **Scouting New Zealand, PO Box 11348, Wellington 6142.**

Note: Using your forms we will enter your personal info into the official AJ2010 database. *This is to ensure that the appropriate people have the correct information at their fingertips during the event.*

## General:

"Webster Packs" is strongly recommended for any person be it scout or leader at AJ2010 who is on regular medication.

ADD medication will not be replaced if lost - NSW Rules.

Meds will be available on site at the pharmacy for any ailment treated on site.

Any forgotten medication will have to be paid for.
