## **SOUTH AUSTRALIAN CONTINGENT INFORMATION**

### **ELIGIBILITY**

- Scouts:**
- Must not have had their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday as at 4 January 2010
  - No extension to this age limit is permitted
  - Must be an invested Scout and hold the Pioneer Badge
  - Have camped in tents as a Scout, for ten (10) nights, at least three (3) of them to be consecutive
  - Must be recommended by their Scout Leader, Group Leader and Contingent Leader.
- Venturer Scouts:**
- Registered members of a Venturer Unit and at least 16 years of age on 4 January 2010
  - Recommended by their Venturer Leader as suitable to serve as a Junior Service Leader
  - Completed the Unit Management and Leadership Course or at least one activity under each Activity area
- Rovers:**
- Registered members of a Rover Crew and at least 18 years of age, but no older than 26 years at 4 January 2010
- Leaders:**
- Must hold a Certificate of Adult Leadership
  - Must have completed all required training components prior to Jamboree as per Branch policy
  - Must be willing to act in any role in which the Contingent Leader considers you are most suited
- Adults:**
- Adults must complete and satisfy a police check in accordance with current Branch Adult Membership Application procedure
  - Must be willing to act in any role in which the Contingent Leader considers you are most suited

Scout applicants are reminded that attendance at a Jamboree is a privilege, not a right, and that behaviour standards will be monitored over the period from point of application acceptance to final application approval date to ascertain attendance eligibility.
