ELIGIBILITY

- Scouts** Must not have had their 15th birthday as at 4 January 2010 ie. Date Of Birth after 5th Jan 1995.
No extension to this age limit is allowed
Must be a registered and invested Scout and hold the Pioneer Badge by December 2009
Have camped as a **Scout**, for ten nights, at least four of these to be consecutive
Be considered by their parents/guardians and Scout Leader to be of both sufficient maturity and good behaviour to successfully participate in the Jamboree
Must be recommended by their Group Leader
- Venturers (Junior Service Leaders)** Will be accepted by the State Contingent on approval from the State Branch Venturer Council
Must be registered members of a Venturer Unit and be between 16 and 18 years of age on 4th January 2010 (ie: Born between 1st January 1992 and 5th January 1994)
- Rovers** Registered members of a Rover Crew at least 18 years of age, but not older than 26 years, at 4th January 2010 will be accepted as Service Leaders, subject to a Police Clearance and Working with Children.
- Line Leaders** Must hold a Certificate of Adult Leadership at 30th September 2009
- Service Leaders** Must hold a Certificate of Adult Membership at 30th September 2009
- Adult Support** Must hold a current Police Clearance and Working With Children as at December 2009

SPECIAL NOTE: NSW State law requires all those attending except those registered attendees who are youth members of a Patrol in a Jamboree Troop to complete a "Prohibited Employment Declaration Form". NSW Law doesn't allow exceptions. This requirement applies to ALL Victorian Venturers, Rovers, Leaders, Adult Support and other helpers (youth or adult).

All Victorian participants must apply via the Victorian Contingent HQ

All Victorian applicants must be part of the Victorian Contingent and pay the Contingent fee

Their Group and/or responsible Commissioner must recommend all applicants as suitable members of the Victorian Contingent

TRANSPORT

The Victorian Contingent Council strongly encourages all YOUTH PARTICIPANTS and JAMBOREE TROOP LEADERS to use Contingent Transport for travel to and from the Jamboree. Air-conditioned coaches will be provided from and return to convenient locations throughout Victoria.

Participants who travel independently both ways will receive a rebate on the applicable Jamboree Fee of \$200. **There will be no reduction in fees for one-way travel.**

Youth participants and Jamboree Troop Line leaders choosing Independent Travel will be notified prior to the Jamboree regarding an assemble drop off and pick up location close to Cataract park

HOW TO APPLY

Applications are to be completed using the on line application form at www.jamboree.vicscouts.asn.au and follow the prompts, you will require your Invitation Code, Scout Registration Number and a digital photograph for inserting into the application form. If you do not have access to the Internet you can obtain a blank form from your Region Office or Branch. Complete the form and request that the Group Leader/District Commissioner/Region Commissioner to enter the details including the photograph onto the Internet on your behalf. **The Jamboree Office will not accept manual applications.** Print off the completed application form, sign and hand to your Group Leader/District Commissioner/Region Commissioner for approval signatures. The Group Leader/District Commissioner/Region Commissioner will confirm the approval on the Internet and an invoice will be mailed or e-mailed directly to you. The Group Leader/District Commissioner/Region Commissioner will then forward the signed copy of the application form to the Victorian Contingent

Ensure that both parent(s) or guardian(s) where applicable, sign the indemnity (Rovers & Leaders are to sign themselves)

All Venturers, Rovers, Leaders/Adults must complete the "Prohibited Employment Declaration Form".

Note to Group Leader/Jamboree Coordinator

1. All application forms must be sent direct to Victorian Contingent to arrive no later than 10th March 2009
2. A Group summary sheet must be filled out and submitted with application forms
3. To facilitate Contingent banking and record arrangements, all payments not done electronically must be by a Group cheque
4. Acknowledgment of receipt of your application and deposit will be by way of the Contingent Newsletter, which will be forwarded to your nominated Group contact in May 2009. No individual receipts will be issued

Late applications cannot be guaranteed attendance at the Jamboree because of the need to finalize arrangements

No more than 6-months old
 Of you looking directly at the camera
 120 by 140 pixels (larger is acceptable, but not smaller)
 In sharp focus and clear
 Of appropriate brightness and contrast and show your skin tones naturally
 Be close up of your head and top of your shoulders so that your face takes up 70-80% of the photograph
 Show you facing square on to the camera, not looking over one shoulder (portrait style)
 Show your eyes open and clearly visible
 Be taken with uniform lighting and not show shadows or flash reflections on your face and no red eye
 If you wear glasses, they must show your eyes clearly with no flash reflection off the glasses, and no tinted lenses or sunglasses
 Show you looking at the camera with a neutral expression and your mouth closed
 Have a plain light-coloured background (no toys, chair backs, parents or siblings visible)

Prohibited Employment Declaration Form

*The Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998 makes it an offence for a prohibited person (a person convicted of a serious sex offence, the murder of a child or a child-related personal violence offence, as well as a Register able person under the *Child Protection (Offenders Registration) Act 2000*) to apply for or otherwise attempt to obtain, undertake or remain in, child-related employment.*

It does not apply if an order from the Industrial Relations Commission, Administrative Decisions Tribunal or Commission for Children and Young People, declares that the Act does not apply to a person in respect of a specific offence.

For further information on what is child-related employment see the ***Working with Children Employer Guidelines***.

Section 33B of the *Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998* defines a serious sex offence as:

- an offence, involving sexual activity or acts of indecency, committed in New South Wales and that was punishable by penal servitude or imprisonment for 12 months or more; or
- an offence, involving sexual activity or acts of indecency, committed elsewhere and that would have been an offence punishable by penal servitude or imprisonment for 12 months or more, if it had been committed in New South Wales; or
- an offence under section 80D or 80E (sexual servitude) of the *Crimes Act 1900*, committed against a child; or
- an offence under Sections 91 D-91 G (child prostitution, other than if committed by a child prostitute) **of the *Crimes Act 1900*** or a similar offence under a law other than a law of New South Wales; or
- an offence under Section 91 H, 578B or 578C (2A) (child pornography) of the ***Crimes Act 1900*** or a similar offence under a law other than a law of New South Wales; or
- an offence of attempting, or of conspiracy or incitement, to commit an offence referred to in the preceding paragraphs; or
- any other offence, whether under the law of New South Wales or elsewhere, prescribed by the regulations.

Note: **A conviction for carnal knowledge is classified as a serious sex offence under this legislation.**

Section 33B of the ***Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998*** defines a child-related personal violence offence as an offence committed by an adult;

- involving intentionally wounding or causing grievous bodily harm to a child; or
- of attempting, or of conspiracy or incitement, to commit such an offence.

Under Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998:

- it is an offence for a prohibited person to apply for or otherwise attempt to obtain, undertake or remain in child related employment;

- Employers must ask existing employees, both paid and unpaid, and preferred applicants for child-related employment to declare if they are a prohibited person or not, all people in child-related employment must inform their employers if they are a prohibited person or remove themselves from child-related employment; and penalties are imposed for non compliance.

I am aware that I am ineligible to apply for or otherwise attempt to obtain, undertake or remain in, child-related employment if I have been convicted of a serious sex offence or child-related personal violence offence as defined in the Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998, or if I am a Registrable Person under the Child Protection (Offenders Registration) Act 2000.

I have read and understood the above information in relation to the Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998. I am aware that it is an offence to make a false statement on this form.

I consent to a check of my relevant criminal records, to verify the statements I have made here, being undertaken by the NSW Commission for Children and Young People for monitoring and auditing purposes in accordance with Section 36 (1)(f) of the Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998.

I declare that I am not a person prohibited by the Act from seeking, obtaining, undertaking or remaining in child related employment.

I understand that this information may be referred to the Commission for Children and Young People and/or to NSW Police for law enforcement purposes and for monitoring and auditing compliance with the procedures and standards for the Working With Children Check in accordance with Section 36 (1)(f) of the Commission for Children and Young People Act 1998.
