WA Information Sheet

ELIGIBILITY

Scouts:

- Must be in the Scout Section.
- Must be an invested Scout and hold the Pioneer Badge before **30th September 2009**.
- Any Scout who has not attained their 11th birth date will be subject to assessment.
- Have camped under canvas as a Scout, for ten (10) nights, at least three (3) of them to be consecutive. Camping with schools and family will not be considered.
- Must not have attained the age of 15 years before the 4th January 2010).
- Be considered by their parents/guardians and Scout Leader to be of both sufficient maturity and good behaviour to successfully participate in the Jamboree.
- Must be recommended by their Scout Leader, Group Leader and District Commissioner and approved by the Contingent Leader.

Venturer Scouts: (Junior Service Leaders)

- Registered members of a Venturer Unit at least 16 years of age on 4th January 2010 and not older than 18 years at the conclusion of AJ2010.
- Will be recommended by both the Unit Council and Venturer Leader as of excellent character and be able to provide a role model to Scouts.
- Achieved the Venturing Skills Award.
- Completed the Unit Management course and the Leadership course or a minimum of one activity under each diamond.
- Hold a certificate of acceptability for WWCC.
- Have a wide experience and understanding of the Venturer Section.
- Must be recommended by their Unit Leader, Group Leader, District Commissioner and Branch Commissioner - Venturers and approved by the Contingent Leader.

Rovers

- Registered members of a Rover Crew at least 18 yrs of age, but no older than 26 years, at 4th January 2010 will be accepted as Service Leaders, subject to a Police Clearance and **MUST** hold a valid Working with Children Card.

Leaders:

- Must hold a Certificate of Adult Leadership as at 30th September 2009.
- Must hold a valid Working With Children Card.

Parent Helper

Registered members of the Association with a Police Clearance & **MUST** hold a Working with Children Card.

All participants must apply via their home State or Contingent. All applicants must be part of their home Contingent and pay the appropriate Contingent fee.

All applicants must be recommended by their Group and/or responsible Commissioner as suitable members of their Contingent.

Applications are due by 31st March 2009.

HOW TO APPLY

Please complete all sections of the attached application form.

Ensure that parent(s) or guardian(s) where applicable, sign the indemnity (Rovers and Leaders are to sign themselves).

Obtain the required signatures as follows:-

Scouts: Scout Leader, Group Leader and District Commissioner.
Venturer: Unit / Venturer Leader, Group Leader, District Commissioner and Branch Commissioner.
Rovers: Group Leader or next appropriate level of Commissioner.
Leader: Group Leader or next appropriate level of Commissioner.

Notes on payments

1. All application forms must be sent direct to Branch to arrive no later than 31st March 2009.
2. If lodged as a Group - A summary sheet must be submitted with application forms.
3. Acknowledgment of receipt of your application and deposit will be by way of the Contingent Newsletter, which will be forwarded with a statement of account in May2009. No individual receipts will be issued.

If a withdrawal is received AFTER to 31st October 2009 – A withdrawal fee of 40% of the Full Contingent & Travel fee will apply

If a withdrawal is received AFTER to 8th December 2009 – No refund will apply

TRANSPORT

The Contingent will travel from Perth by Air and details will be advised in due course. Independent travel by troops is not allowed. Youth members or Leaders seeking to travel independently by their own means must make clear written application to the Contingent Leader who will respond with clearly set out guidelines and instructions
